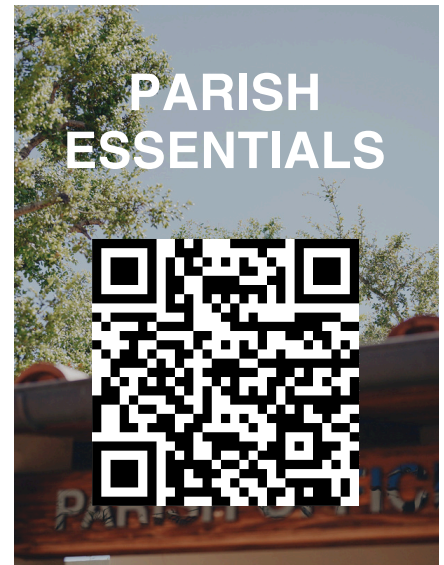
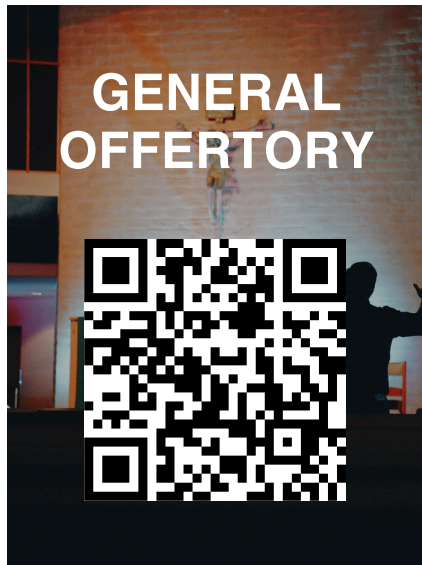

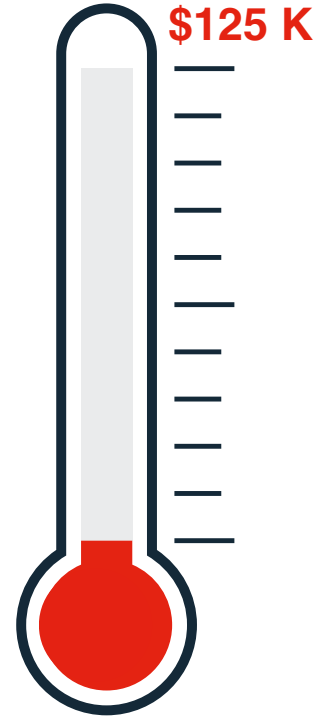




# FEED SOLANO
