





ENRICHMENTS: Twice a month sessions where we focus on the teachings of the Catholic Church. These sessions are meant to build up strong young Catholics and to help our students understand what they are saying yes to in the Sacrament of Confirmation



ROOT: Root is a foundational catechetical experience focusing on the Creed for teens and parents, with age appropriate content for each. Over the course of 6 Family Meetings, families will grow into a deeper understanding of our faith as they are led through the contents of the first part of the Catechism of the Catholic Church.



XLT: XLT is a night of Worship and Adoration. As Catholics, the Eucharist is central to our faith and our hope is that our students will encounter the living God through this time in Adoration.



SERVICE: The Solano staff and volunteers create an environment where people want to stay and grow in their faith. Our confirmandi are invited into that process through a **10 hour per year** service commitment of their choosing. Students get to share in the ministries of our parish and learn what makes our community so unique while gaining a better understanding of what being a "disciple" of Jesus entails.



RETREAT: Retreats are required for both Year 1 and Year 2 students. These weekends provide the necessary disconnect we all need to be able to pray, learn, discern, and connect with our creator.



PARENT & STUDENT RETREAT DAYS: Two (3 hour long) mini retreats that are designed to give parents and students the opportunity to connect and share in the confirmation journey.



BISHOP LETTER: (YEAR 2 ONLY). Students are required to write a personal letter to our Bishops, presenting themselves as ready and willing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. A guide for this requirement is provided.



MASS: It is understood that any Catholic seeking to become fully initiated in the faith, is attending Sunday Mass weekly. Mass isn't something that Catholics just do, in it we receive the "source and summit" of who we are.

Choosing a Confirmation Sponsor Guide

Choosing your Confirmation Sponsor is an important part of your spiritual journey and also in your spiritual formation. The role of the Confirmation sponsor is to support you in your journey of faith and to stand up with you to say you are ready to receive the Sacrament. Unfortunately, parents are not eligible to be sponsors for candidates.

The Role of a Sponsor:

The sponsor represents the support and prayers of the entire Church. He or she will be the candidate's support system through the Confirmation process. Sponsors need to:

- Confirmation rehearsal, and Confirmation ceremony
- Meet with his or her candidate as often as possible for support
- Share his or her faith story with their candidate
- Spend time getting to know their candidate
- Pray for their candidate
- Present the candidate during the Liturgy of Confirmation
- Continue to lend support to their candidate after the Confirmation process is complete
- Encourage the candidate to move forward in his or her faith journey

Requirements to be a Sponsor:

- Must be a practicing Catholic and must model Christian values in their daily life
- Attends Sunday Mass regularly
- Be a person suitable for this role, selected by the teen, and having intention of fulfilling this role
- Be at least 16 years of age
- Be fully initiated into the Roman Catholic Church, having received Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist.
- If married, be married in the Roman Catholic Church
- If you are divorced and remarried, your prior marriage has been annulled by the Church.
- Be neither the mother or father of the person to be Confirmed
