We are so grateful you answered God's call to serve him in the ministry. As the coordinator, my first priority is to ensure that all Masses have altar servers scheduled. My next responsibility is to ensure that your preferences are respected. The only fair way to accomplish this is to establish "required Masses" where servers are in short supply. But allow you some choice in the matter. It is our current policy than that at least once per year, all servers are required to serve a Saturday, 5:00 p.m. Servers will be able to indicate their availability each quarter. A 2nd training is required after completing two years of service to learn Cross Bearer and incense duties. You may not be a cross bearer until that training is complete and you have grown big enough to handle the heavy cross. Regarding safety and accountability Altar Serving is also a good way for our young people to learn to communicate via emails with adults and become responsible for their time commitments. However, they need help. Parents, please allow the children to type and send the emails requesting substitutes. It is good practice. However, we insist that a parent is typically always

copied on email or text correspondence with a child. If your altar server does not yet have their own email, please update your records when they do.

Altar Servers are required to sign-in 15 minutes prior to the beginning of mass. Most cannot drive themselves to church, but they can be responsible for leaving the house on time and keeping track of their own appointed schedules. Can't serve dates for the next quarter are due no later than the 21st prior to scheduling. You may load can't serve dates for months in advance if you know your availability. This is immensely helpful!
